Phase 1 of the mission ended by October 2019. Phase 2 of the Mission is live till 2024-25 and aims to sustain the open defecation free status and improve the management of solid and liquid waste. The mission is also aimed at progressing towards targets of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations (UN) in 2012.

Udaipur Municipal Corporation (UMC)/ Udaipur Smart City Ltd. (USCL) is committed to improve solid and liquid waste management of the Udaipur to make it a cleaner and greener city and is continuously making efforts towards achieving the same.
