# Summary of the events held

Widespread stakeholder engagements were done with respect to the various deliverables to make progress in the Urban95 Phase-II during these months (Aug'21-Jan'22)

- A. The **Launch Workshop** for the Urban95 Phase-II was organized on 6<sup>th</sup> August'21 with the support of UMC & PMSU with an aim to announce the program to larger pool of audience consisting of various government- UMC, UIT, Institute of Town Planners, India (ITPI), Udaipur Chapter, Udaipur Police, Education and Health dept., Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS), Ministry of Women and Child Development and non- government organization- NGOs, Trust, Universities, Architects, Planners individuals/ groups working in related domain. Around 100 people participated in the Launch workshop organized virtually.
- B. An introductory meeting was organized between PMU (ICLEI South Asia & ECORYS India) & Parents + (Jatan Sansthaan) team in the conference hall of Udaipur Smart Ltd. by PMSU in the month of October'21.
- C. The Two days online training was organised under the **Street for Kids (SFK)** program on 15<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> Nov'21 which was focused towards making child friendly streets.
- D. A **Progress Review Meeting** was organized by PMU in coordination with PMSU on 26<sup>th</sup> January'22 to apprise the UMC officials on the progress made under the Urban95 Phase-II in the first year of the project along with showcasing the activities to be implemented in the second year of the project.

## 1. Background

This report covers the information on the engagements done with various stakeholders in the months of August'21 to January'22 under the Urban95 Phase-II with reference to various activities.

## 2. About Urban95 Program

The Bernard van Leer Foundation's Urban95 initiative seeks to make lasting change in the city landscapes and in the opportunities that shape the crucial first five years of children's lives. It is rooted in the belief that well-functioning neighborhoods in urban areas foster strong communities as well as economic development. BvLF supports citywide initiatives through technical and financial support to partner cities.

# 3. Urban95 Phase-II

Following Urban95 Phase-I, Udaipur has now entered Urban95 Phase-II, which focuses on scaling up and sustainability of various "lighthouse" projects in neighborhoods, streets and junctions, parks, and health facilities, incorporating Urban95 components in the policy. It promulgates the idea to build a broad coalition of support using trainings and peer learning, enhancing the institutional capacity and to involve relevant stakeholders in initiatives and projects.

# 4. Engagement done/Stakeholders met in the city

### A. Engagements of August'21 month

- 1. Meetings conducted to invite Important Stakeholders in the Urban95 Phase-II Launch Workshop (Virtual)
- A. Meetings were done with Commissioner, Udaipur Municipal Corporation towards the end of July'21 and it was decided to organize the Launch workshop virtually on 6<sup>th</sup> August'21.
- B. Team Leader & City Coordinator from PMSU met with Mr. Arun Kumar Hasija, Secretary UIT to update about the project and also to invite him for the launch workshop. Team Leader and City Coordinator, BvLF met with Mr. B.L. Kothari, Advisor to UIT to brief about the ongoing works of the project and also to invite him in the launch workshop virtually. Both meetings were done on 2nd August, 2021.

- C. Team Leader & City Coordinator from PMSU met with Mr. Arvind Kumar, Public Relation Officer (PRO), UMC on 3<sup>rd</sup> August for the coverage of the workshop in media. He was narrated and briefed about the project along with the workshop schedules. Later he was given thanks for the good media coverage.
- D. Team Leader & City Coordinator met with Dr. Rajeev Pachar IPS, Superintendent of Police, Udaipur to invite him in the launch workshop. Although he shared that he is on tour, the workshop details were communicated to him and his PA.
- E. TL & City Coordinator from PMSU also met with Mr. Satya Veer Singh, IG police and also invited him for the launch workshop. District Collector was also approached, but as he was busy in various other important meetings, he was unable to meet.

### 1.1 Key outcomes of the meeting

i. Meeting was done with various stakeholders in the city with a focus on updating the stakeholders on the Launch workshop and also sharing the Program progress with them.

### 2. Launch Workshop

The Launch Workshop was organized on 6<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 virtually in the conference hall of Smart City office from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM, IST. This workshop was organized with an objective to showcase and share various activities to be carried out under the program along with sharing outcome, challenges and learnings from Phase-I while attempting to transform Udaipur into an ITC Friendly and ITC Responsive city.

- A. PMU & PMSU made necessary arrangements for the participants (Elected representatives & Officials from UMC) to attend the workshop and sent invitations to various stakeholders which included officials from various Government departments in Udaipur, viz, UIT, Traffic, ICDS, Education, Health etc. Various members/people from ground level NGOs, active groups working in the same domain & relevant members were invited to attend the Launch workshop virtually.
- B. It was jointly chaired & inaugurated by Mr. Govind Singh Taunk, Mayor Udaipur & Mr. Paras Singhvi, Dy, Mayor Udaipur. It was joined by Mr. Himmart Singh Barhath, Commissioner, Udaipur Municipal Corporation & Mr Mukesh Pujari, Superintending Engineer from UMC & USCL.
- C. Stakeholders were shared about the details of upcoming projects to be done in partnership with UMC under the Urban95 Phase-II in detail and were also shared an insight of the program through two presentations. The stakeholders were also informed about the journey of the Urban95 program through a short video which was well appreciated by UMC & the stakeholders.

- D. BvLF representatives also shared few of the international cities as examples in the field of promoting the early childhood development and also shared how Udaipur city is leading towards to become a "light house" city in this field. Stakeholders were thanked for the support given during the entire course of the Urban95 Phase-I & Phase-II till now and were requested to continue supporting the same.
- E. UMC officials & representatives shared with BvLF, technical partners and all the stakeholders present during the Launch workshop that they shall provide the required support in implementing the projects in the Urban95 Phase-II as well & would put more efforts to be a light house city.
- F. A short presentation was also presented on Street for Kids (SfK) Program, Udaipur by the NACTO team member.


### 2.1 Key outcomes of the Launch workshop

### B. Engagements of September'21 month

### 1. Meeting conducted with UIT for CPZ intervention

A. A meeting was conducted with Mr. B.L. Kothari, Senior Advisor to UIT on 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept'21 regarding the CPZ area identification and the upcoming projects from UIT. This meeting was attended by members from PMSU & PMU.

### 1.1 Key outcomes of the meeting

- i. It was advised to take up new Meera Nagar and Chitrakoot Nagar (for the upcoming neighbourhood).
- ii. Regarding the intervention to be done under the 1.5 km child friendly stretch, it came out that few of the city roads are maintained by the PWD.

### 2. Meetings with PWD Department for the 1.5 km Child Friendly Stretch

A. TL and UD expert had a meeting with Mr. Ashok Sharma SE, PWD on 13<sup>th</sup> September'21. He shared the list of roads to be taken up by the PWD department in the city under the CM budget for road repair (carpeting work). Team members shared information related to the 1.5 km Child Friendly Stretch to which there was a positive response. PWD officials suggested the team members to come along with the design/proposal on the selected road stretch (under the Urban95 Program) and they can think over it. SE shared that PWD can take up the components to be added in the 10% (updated revised cost of the total tender) if it can be completed under that.

#### 2.1 Key outcomes are as under:

i. The discussions lead to the new CM budget announcement of the city roads which can be taken up as the ITC destinations.

- ii. SE PWD gave team members a brief understanding of how they are just taking up repair and carpeting work in the CM budget.
- iii. Official shared the list of the roads which they are taking up in the budget.

### 3. Meetings with UMC for the 1.5 km Child Friendly Stretch

A. A meeting was done with Mr. Mukesh Pujari, SE, UMC & USCL on the road stretches of Hiranmagri (Smart city road) and Shashtri Nagar to Ayad Pulia on 13<sup>th</sup> September'21. This meeting was attended by members from PMSU & PMU. It was shared that PMU should look upon different options as they have exhausted with budget on the Hiranmagri smart city road and now there is no budget left for any other activities to be taken under the same. Superintendent Engineer UMC was open to PMU to discuss with UIT for their upcoming projects and advised if those are viable to be taken up as the Urban95 initiative.

### 3.1 Key outcomes are as under:

- i. SE UMC suggested taking up different options as they have already exhausted on the Hiran Magri road and no budget is left for any other activities to be taken up.
- ii. They were open to PMU to discuss with UIT for their upcoming projects and PMU can see if those are viable to take up as the Urban95 initiative.

### 1. Street for Kids (SFK) design Workshop





The meeting was also called for taking the date from Commissioner, UMC for hosting the 1st PSC, apprising them about the Program progress, taking their views, submissions approvals (Inception Report, MPRs, and Stakeholder Engagement Report etc.) and support required from them.

### 2. Kids Festival

- A. Regarding the Kids Festival PMU had multiple discussions with PMSU and accordingly the detailed presentations have been prepared focusing on scaling up the same in form of activities, stakeholders, overall participation, process etc. The same has been discussed with Commissioner, UMC and other UMC champions on 26<sup>th</sup> Jan'22 for their approval not only on site for hosting the same but also on the proposed activities in the festival along with support required from them and other stakeholders (West Zone Cultural Centre, ICDS, District Education Officer (Elementary), CMHO etc.) with their leadership.
- B. PMU has also did a site visit to potential sites (Pandit Deendayal Upadhya Park at Dudh Talai and Gulab Bagh) to gauge the potential of particular site in hosting the Festival as envisioned and also to gauge existing condition of the venue from ITC perspective along with identifying ITCN motivators & barriers. PMU and PMSU also went for a joint site visit on 29th Jan'22 to all the potential sites (1.5 kms stretch, CPZs, and Kids Festival) to gauge the feel of all the sites in-person.


### 3. BOQ document of Dewali Sunset Point





### 4. Child Priority Zones (CPZs)

A. On the Child Priority Zones discussion happened between UD expert and PMSU and it was suggested updating the presentation with adding ward details, to add young children population in the data sheet, to add the children attraction/magnet points in the selected sites and bringing the inferences for the same. Community engagements were done along with one on one interaction which helped bringing outcomes with reference to end users. The inferences of the engagements done on the CPZ sites are as under:







- The survey was taken between 5-6 pm on a weekday to understand the footfall in the park, interact with the stakeholders and develop insights from their patterns of visiting and amount of time spent on site The visiting hours are similar and coordinated amongst
- caregivers so that their children can socialize and
- play with other children People who visit the park from far away locations are irregular and come once or twice a week
- Distance signages
- Lack of hygiene-park equipment should be cleaned and sanitized regularly Elements for road safety to slow down the
- fast-moving cars
- Temporary shutdown of intermediate streets on weekend for limited hours where kids can play
- Streetlights not sufficient/ functioning Female caregivers are dominant as most of them are home-workers hence can take out time for their kids

## 5. Way Forward

On the revised Technical Proposal submitted by PMU on 26<sup>th</sup> July'21 BvLF suggested PMU team to highlight the changes done in the Technical Proposal to which the revised Technical Proposal with updated Work Plan was submitted on 30<sup>th</sup> August'21. Later it was revised with the support from PMSU and final version along with the action plan was submitted on 27<sup>th</sup> Jan'22 after many revisions.

It was envisaged by PMU to organize the first PSC meeting in the month of Feb'22 to showcase the project progress with reference to the various activities and to get the multiple documents approved from the PSC members.

PMU team plans to conduct the First Kids Festival under the Urban95 Phase-II in the month of February'22. PMU plans to finalize the required collaterals, presentation explaining the details of the activities to be conducted, identifying various potential persons/stakeholders for conducting the activities etc. PMU plans to finalize the dates & potential site for organizing the Kids Festival and also following up with relevant stakeholders like Schools, Aanganwadis etc.

PMU team plans to finalize the FGD instruments with the support of PMSU & TAG and to conduct the FGDs on ground covering the envisaged ITC destinations. PMU targets to cover the Final report by the end of April'22.

As discussed during the 26<sup>th</sup> Jan'22 project progress review meeting, PMU team plans to develop the proposal for the 1.5 km Child Friendly Stretch and three Family Friendly Junctions taking Saheliyon ki badi to Sukhadia stretch. PMU team also plans to develop a model (100 mts) having induced with ITC elements & components.

PMU team also plans to finalize the presentations/draft documents for the Child Priority Zones with PMSU and to take them in the next stage of preparation of Feasibility reports for the selected sites in discussion with the UMC officials. Preparations of the DPRs shall be done after the feasibility followed by the floating of tender and to implement the same coating it as a reference.

The first Capacity Building shall be organized in the first quarter of the project which shall be organized on the subject of the Child Priority Zones (Feasibility Report Stage) and the concerned stakeholders shall be invited to attend the same.

PMU plans to finalize the designs along with cost estimates of the Semi-Permanent projects with the support from PMSU. These shall be implemented with the support from of UMC and the implementation is planned in the first quarter.

PMU team envisages having meetings with various important stakeholders on regular basis to showcase the progress as well as to keep them intact in the decisions taken. It shall help in moving the things forward and to keep the stakeholders active.
